



## Academic English and Study Skills Pre-sessional Courses 2017 - 2018

The University of Strathclyde offers a high quality suite of Academic English and Study Skills courses for international students aiming to study undergraduate and postgraduate degrees at the University.

Some of the key features include:

- Up to 42 week's preparation, with multiple entry points according to students' English language proficiency level
- A focus on useful learning, i.e. on real-life situations and tasks which applicants are likely to face during their degrees or future careers
- Access to self-access resources with audio visual, reference and interactive computer-based language learning materials
- Free access to the Internet and computer labs, as well as use of the University's extensive library facilities
- Opportunities to visit places of cultural, historical and leisure interest in Glasgow and around Scotland

\*Teaching for Foundation 3-4, plus Modules 1-3, will begin on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2018. Registration and induction events will take place in week beginning Monday 5<sup>th</sup> March, 2018.

- The Module 3 component is offered free of charge to applicants from all courses who go on to register on a full-time course of at least 9 months in duration and pay full overseas fees. Applicants from Foundation courses plus Modules 1-3, and from Modules 1-3 and Modules 2-3, will be required to pay the Module 3 fees in advance (£1,450). The Module 3 fee will be refunded on confirmation of continued registration and payment of full overseas fees for a full-time course of at least 9 months in duration.

- The deadline for applications for Pre-Sessional Module 3 is Friday 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. Applicants need to be aware that this is a deadline and that only those who apply on or before July 13<sup>th</sup> can be accepted for Module 3.
- Teaching for Foundation 3-4, plus Modules 1-3, will begin on 12th March, 2018. Registration and induction events will take place in week beginning Monday 5th March 2018. The course dates include Spring Vacation 2<sup>nd</sup> April to 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 – there will be no classes during this period.
- The University will be closed on the following dates: 30<sup>th</sup> March & 2<sup>nd</sup> April, May 7<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, July 13<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018. There will be no classes on these dates.

### Class Hours

Each Pre-Sessional module offers 21 hours per week of task-based, communicative classroom learning, delivered by a team of experienced ELT staff.

### How to Apply

1. Consult with your academic department selector on your starting level and entry date (see Entry Level tables)

3. Email the completed form to [elt@strath.ac.uk](mailto:elt@strath.ac.uk) together with the following documents:
  - a. copies of the personal information and photograph pages of your passport
  - b. a copy of your current UK visa (if you have one)
  - c. a copy of the results of any previous English test you have taken
  - d. a copy of your offer letter from the University of Strathclyde (if you have one)
4. The University will advise you on length of study and send you a Confirmation of Attendance for Studies (CAS) letter for visa purposes
